

Resolution to amend the Constitution

Introduction: Members are asked to approve the following motion to become operational from January 2018.

This meeting notes:

The current CILIPS constitution does not permit direct membership of CILIPS

This meeting believes:

“That CILIPS should offer direct membership of CILIPS in addition to the current membership option”

This meeting resolves:

To amend the CILIPS Constitution to permit direct membership of CILIPS from 1st January 2018.

The proposed constitutional amendment is set out below.

Qualifications for membership

Membership is open to:

Any individual or organisation who wishes to become a non voting member in the category ‘friend or supporter’ of CILIP in Scotland;

Non-voting members are individuals or bodies who support the charitable objectives of CILIPS.

Application for membership

Any individual or body who wishes to become a member must sign a written application for membership; the application will then be considered by the board at its next board meeting.

The board must notify each applicant promptly (in writing or by e-mail) of its decision on whether or not to admit him/her to membership.

Membership subscription

An annual membership subscription will be payable.
